

SYNOPSIS

- Scene 5 The arena of the big tent (Later that night)

Act 2

- Scene 6 The Deck of the Cattle Boat (eight months later)
- Scene 7 Ballroom of the Hotel Brevoort (The next night)
- Scene 8 The Governors Island Ferry (Next morning)
- Scene 9 Governors Island (Later in the morning)
